



Why study Level 3 Core Maths

The new Core Maths Level 3 qualification is for students who have passed GCSE at grade 5 or above but have decided not to study A level Mathematics.

Core Maths builds upon and strengthens the existing skills developed during their GCSE maths course. There is a sharper focus on problem-solving and using and applying mathematics to solve problems relevant to students' everyday lives. This includes financial applications of mathematics as well as further statistical ideas that can support work in other subjects such as Psychology, Business Studies, Geography, Sociology, Economics and Biology.

The skills developed in the study of Mathematics are increasingly important in the workplace and in higher education. Universities have welcomed the new Core Maths qualification as students will be better equipped with the mathematical skills that are required for many degree courses. Studying Core Maths will help students improve their career choices.

Core Maths is a one year course.
