## Curriculum Intent Statement

### At Lunesdale Learning Trust in Art we will enable pupils to develop:

- Creativity – to develop creativity through engaging Scheme of Work
- Independence – by working on independent projects and encouraging students to make their own personal responses to topics
- Problem solving -- by giving challenging art activities that include developing and refining ideas
- Experimentation -allowing students to experience and build on a multiple range of different artistic techniques
- Outcomes – for the students to be able to produce final pieces having followed a project plan and make decisions along the way
- Disciplines- to introduce the students to a multiple number of different materials to work with including both 2 D, 3 D and digital work.
- Analysis – to be able to analyse and evaluate their own work and work of others
- Risk taking – to think for themselves and take risks, try new things even if they are unsuccessful
